Risk Calculator

To be used in determining the level of risk in conjunction with the Risk Analysis Form (RM - RA) and Risk Management Plan Form (RM - RMP) and according to the guidelines set out in the Risk Management and Activity Planning procedure documents.

Step 1 – Assess the **Likelihood of Occurrence** and select the **Code**

Code	Likelihood of Occurrence	Description
A	Almost certain	The event is expected to occur in most circumstances
B	Likely	The event will probably occur in most circumstances
C	Moderate	The event should occur at some time
D	Unlikely	The event could occur at some time
E	Rare	The event may occur only in exceptional circumstances

Step 2 – Determine **Possible Consequence** of and select the **Code**

Code	Possible Consequence	Description
1	Intolerable	Death; high public embarrassment; major financial loss; Potential legal action.
2	Substantial	Extensive injury, medium level public embarrassment, significant financial loss.
3	Moderate	Medical treatment required, high financial loss, possible public embarrassment.
4	Minor	First Aid Treatment, little public interest, negligible financial loss.
5	Trivial	No injury, no financial loss or media interest.

Step 3 – Match the **Likelihood of Occurrence** with the **Possible Consequence**

Likelihood	Possible Consequences				
	Intolerable 1	Substantial 2	Moderate 3	Minor 4	Trivial 5
A almost certain

E rare					

H = High/unacceptable - requires immediate action

S = Significant - requires urgent attention

M = Moderate - needs to be addressed

L = Low risk - requires management by routine procedures and review of risk.
