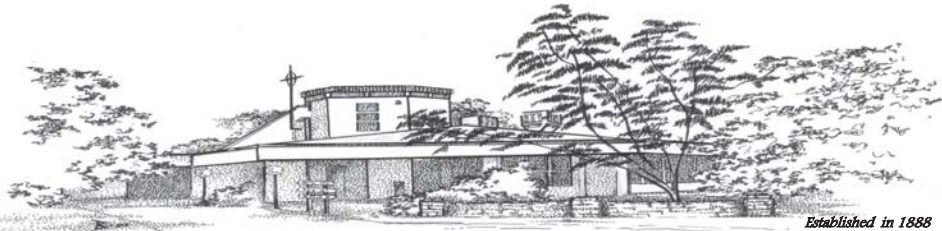

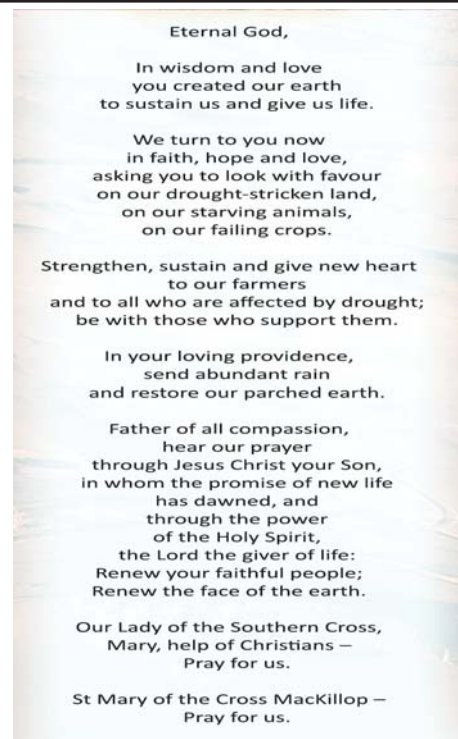

## “Ministry Matters”

### Proclamation of the Word (AKA Reading Ministry)

What I hear most from other parishioners if I mention I am reading at Mass is, “Oh I could never do that!” If I am truthful I would have said it myself, or certainly thought it. But, I got asked to read, in fact it was not quite a question, it was more like, ‘Yvonne you’ll do the reading, won’t you!’ I was new to the Church, having come in through RCIA, and I just assumed that it was another Right of Passage; you are here now, so we will give you a job.

I did overcome my nerves and step up, and I have never regretted taking on what was a challenge to me at the time. Because the Parish Office makes sure you have a copy of the reading to become familiar with and to practice reading out loud, your focus changes. It has helped me learn to read my Bible, and to pray. Not just to understand the message of the Scripture I’m reading but how to apply what I’m discovering to my everyday life and it has helped reveal the Holy Spirit to me in a way that has changed my life. Finding time for daily reading of the Scriptures and prayer is no longer ‘something I should do’ but something I can’t live without.

We belong to the Body of Christ, the Church. When a reader leaves the pews and goes to the lectern we are not special. Yes, we are sharing the Word of God which is special, but we are not special. We are using our gifts to strengthen the Body of Christ. Sometimes we stumble on pronunciation, we lose our place, or we get asked to read with no preparation because the Reader on roster is unavailable.

We do our very best because being of service to you is the reason we read; belonging and being a part of this community, giving back to you is the real gift. I would sincerely encourage anyone considering a Ministry to give the Reading Ministry a try, because any small thing matters so much.
