Plenary Council

One of the six thematic papers that have been developed as part of the discernment process is:

*How is God calling us to be a Christ-centred Church in Australia that is **A Joyful, Hope-Filled & Servant Community?***

This Theme was inspired by the voices of the People of God who expressed a yearning for the Church to be a sign of God's kingdom for all people – to be able to see the Catholic Church in action, and to recognise Jesus. There was an expression of faith-filled hope in the capacity of the Catholic community to celebrate together, to show what it is to be a follower of Christ and to be loved unconditionally by God. There was a call to contemplate the Gospel call to be a servant Church for the good of all people – particularly for the most vulnerable. Many responses called for greater sharing of the story of the good works done by so many people and organisations of the Church.

"Each day they met together in the Temple; they broke bread in their homes; they shared their food with great joy and sincerity of heart; they praised God and won the favour of all the people"
