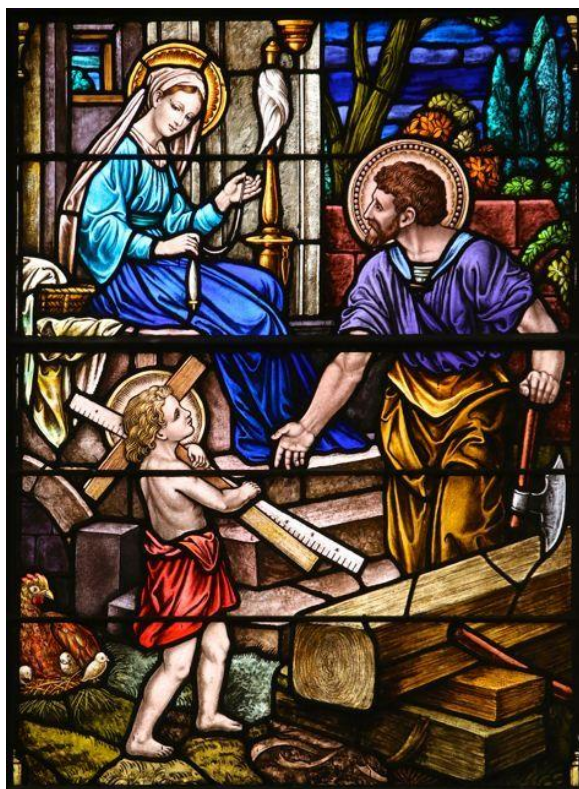


Rosary for the Vocation of the Family



The Rosary

Sign of the Cross:

In the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit,
Amen.

The Apostle's Creed:

Ÿ. I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth, and in in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Ŕ. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The First Joyful Mystery

The Annunciation:

The angel said to her, 'Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favour with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. He will reign over the house of Jacob for ever, and of his kingdom there will be no end.' Mary said to the angel, 'How can this be, since I am a virgin?' The angel said to her, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God. And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. For nothing will be impossible with God.' Then Mary said, 'Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word.' Then the angel departed from her.

Intention:

Lord, you call all of us to follow you in our own vocation. Mary responded whole-heartedly to your call despite not knowing exactly where it would lead her. Help our family to be open to your call in our lives, and, like Mary, to respond to that call with generosity.

And why has this happened to me, that the mother of my Lord comes to me? For as soon as I heard the sound of your greeting, the child in my womb leapt for joy. And blessed is she who believed that there would be a fulfilment of what was spoken to her by the Lord.'

Intention:

Lord, your Spirit moves our hearts to be filled with love. Help us not to hesitate in following your call due to fears and doubts. We pray for the grace to follow the example of Mary who immediately responds to God's call with courage and a spirit of compassionate love. We ask you to take away any anxieties or fears in our family and replace them with your peace and joy.

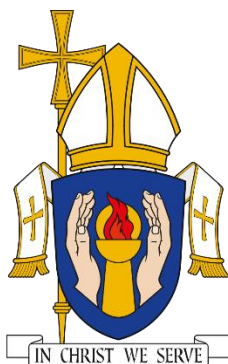
We pray to You for children and young people: may they encounter You and respond joyfully to the vocation You have in mind for them.
