### PRIEST'S REFLECTION

The Gospel narrative of today is part of Jesus' last discourse to his disciples at the last Supper. Here he gave them a new commandment of love:

"I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples if you have love for one another" (John 13:34-35).

The newness of Jesus' teaching lies in the analogy of Jesus using himself as a perfect measure of love when he said: just as I have loved you, you also love one another. Jesus' new commandment calls for love without limits, unconditional love, love that is sacrificial and selfless. True love should be the trademark of all Christians.
