THE BISHOP'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

This Sunday we read the story of Abraham and Sarah, who welcomed the visitors and provided hospitality, working together to ensure their visitors were cared for. In the Gospel, Mary and Martha similarly welcomed Jesus into their home and together offered hospitality to Him. As the Gospel reminds us, it is a lesson in discipleship to listen together, hear the message and move on to mission. This is taking co-responsibility for the Mission of Jesus. The faithfulness of Abraham and Sarah, Mary and Martha, is an example to all of us of welcoming God and the Disciples.

This weekend as we reflect on the scriptures and nourished with the Eucharist, we too are invited as Missionary Disciples of Jesus Christ to be connected with our parish and the work of our parish. Each week the newsletter outlines various ways of connection and inclusion.

I will join you with my prayers from afar this weekend as I am visiting the Walkerston parish, celebrating Confirmation, First Holy Communion, blessing and opening new buildings at St John's Primary School and celebrating the NAIDOC Mass for the Mackay region. In preparing for the blessing and opening it is fascinating going back in the history of the parish and the great connections of the Sisters of Mercy, who founded first a convent, then a place of Catholic education for our young people and finally a school as part of the parish.

Next week we celebrate through the Diocese, Catholic Education Week, where we remember the very humble beginnings when lay teachers formed catechetical schools in many parts of the Diocese, including here in Rockhampton in Alma Street. They were then joined by the religious Sisters and Brothers who continued Catholic Education. Catholic Education with its 32 schools and 9 colleges, with St Brendan's College, St Ursula's College and the Flexible Learning Centre educate over 17,000 young people in our Diocese. As we look forward to Catholic Education Week we give thanks to those who lead our schools, teachers and staff, and may God bless all of their endeavours.

JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS




