# **BISHOP'S MESSAGE**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

I write at the beginning of November and invite you to celebrate on Tuesday 1 November, All Saint's Day, which originally was a holy day of obligation, but is still important in our church calendar as we remember all those who have become Saints. In fact, we are all Saints in the making as we live our lives and try to do the very best and hopefully, one day, we will be numbered among the Saints of God as they enjoy eternal peace with our God.

The second day I draw your attention to is All Soul's Day on Wednesday 2 November. I invite you to come and celebrate Mass on this day. It is a day we remember all those who have died - our relatives, friends and those in our communities. We invite you to come and pray for them. The evening Mass at Holy Family Church will be a special Mass of Remembrance for all who have lost loved ones last year. You may wish to join us in praying for those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.

The Cathedral roof is almost complete and I am told it will be finished mid-November. Over the weekend of the 12 & 13 November we look forward to welcoming you back to our Cathedral without scaffolding and building materials, and being returned to its pristine condition. It has been a long six months while the roof has been replaced and many people have made many sacrifices during these months so workers could speedily and efficiently replace the roof. It has been a mammoth exercise and I believed it would only take a couple of weeks, but it was nearly as extensive as building a new Cathedral. So I welcome you back on the weekend of 12 & 13 November and will celebrate with morning tea after the Sunday 9.30am Mass. Our weekday Masses will begin on 14 November as follows: Monday 7.00am, Tuesday 5.30pm, Wednesday 12 midday. Thursday 8am. Friday 12 midday and Saturday 9am.

This weekend I am in Barcaldine celebrating 125 years of the school and will also visit the Longreach and Blackall communities. Last weekend I celebrated Confirmations in the Central Highlands. Next weekend I will be on my way to the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference meeting as we gather in Sydney for the week.
