### **Mission Sunday**

Today Catholics all over the world, observe World Mission Sunday. Pope Pius XI instituted this annual observance in 1926 by Papal decree. Every year since then, the universal Church has dedicated the month of October to reflection on, and prayer for, the missions. On World Mission Sunday, Catholics gather to celebrate the Eucharist and to contribute to a collection for the work of evangelisation around the world. This annual celebration gives us a chance to reflect on the importance of mission work for the life of the Church. It reminds us that we are one with the Church around the world and that we are all committed to carrying on the mission of Christ, however different our situations may be.

I remember the mission Sunday activities back home in Cochin, India. It is a big celebration. We have many activities on Mission Sunday. There are different stalls, food courts, auction centers, entertainment, and games. At the beginning of October, the parish will distribute the Mission Sunday envelope to each and everyone's house. The Mission Sunday envelopes will be returned with contributions at the end of the month. Through this program the parish collects a good number of contributions for missions.

Secondly, most of the parishes organise different mission stalls around the church compound. The stalls are run by the church organisations. They collect grocery items, fruits and vegetables, etc from the people and people donate them for mission. With the mission spirit, they sell everything at a good price. There are a variety of food courts of traditional foods, handicrafts stalls and entertainment centers for children, which are also an attraction of mission week. For the parish, the month of October is a month for prayers and mission activities. Everyone has the spirit and feeling that we are doing wonderful mission work along with the missionaries across the world during these mission weeks.

We are all missionaries by baptism. Let us celebrate this month as a mission month for missionaries. This year we are invited to support families from disadvantaged backgrounds through programs like the Maria Auxiliadora Clinic run by the sisters in Timor-Leste. 
