Syro-Malabar Church (has an Eparchy (Diocese) in Australia, + is one of the main Churches in India)

The Churches with Eparchies (Dioceses) have an Eparch (Bishop), Parishes, priests, and most also have their own Church buildings, schools and charitable and missionary organisations. The Eparchs are all members of the Australian Catholic Bishops' Conference (ACBC). Due to the great cost of building/purchasing Church buildings, many Eastern Catholic Churches celebrate regular services in their own Rite, in the buildings of Latin Catholic Churches.

While Eastern Rite Catholics only account for 1.5% of Australian Catholics (2021 Census data), their numbers are rapidly growing. The number of Chaldean Catholics increased by 41% between 2016 & 2021! Eastern Catholic Churches are also more likely to have younger parishioners, with only 2.2% of Syro-Malabar Catholics in Australia aged over 60!
