LEARNING MORE ABOUT THE MASS

With so many families preparing their children to receive Jesus in Holy Communion in May, we thought it might be helpful to look at eight prayers that are said at Mass.

Do you know the first prayer at Mass? Of course, it is the Sign of the Cross.

For many of us it was the first prayer we learnt, and it was a challenge trying to remember which hand to use and which shoulder to touch first. This prayer with its words and actions is very distinctly Catholic. Is there more to it?

Edward Sri in his book, "A Biblical Walk through the Mass" wrote, "In making this sign, we invoke God's presence and invite him to bless us, assist us, and guard us from all harm. It is not surprising that the early Christians made the Sign of the Cross guite often in their daily lives." St John Chrysostom advised, "Never leave your house without making the sign of the cross."

In this prayer, we call upon God's name like Abraham who "calls on the name of the Lord when he is erecting altars to God." (see Genesis 12:8; 13:4; 21:33) "In Scripture, a name is not merely a conventional way of referring to a particular person... to call upon God's name is to invoke his presence and his power". As we read in Psalm 124:8, "our help is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth".

So, every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we should do it with careful attention and reverence.

One other suggestion from Edward Sri is for parents to make the sign of the cross on the foreheads of their children when they put them to bed at night, as he does.

In the Gospel of John 17:21 the phrase "that the world may believe" has been so strongly emphasized, that at times we run the risk of forgetting that, in the evangelist's mind, "unity is above all, for the glory of God". At the same time, it is obvious that the lack of unity among Christians seems to contradict this Truth - that we as Christians have this as our mission. Pope Paul points out, that as a consequence, we "may, gravely damage our witness". (see Paul VI, Art 98 "That They May All Be One").
