WHAT IS RCICCA?

RCICCA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age. This Rite is for children over the age of 7yrs and younger than 14yrs, who have not been baptized and who wish to be fully initiated into the Catholic church. The RCICCA program follows a similar for-

mat as the adult RCIA program but has been adapted for the age of the children. Currently we have 17 children enrolled in the RCICCA program preparing to receive all three of the Sacraments of Initiation on Ascension Sunday, May 12 during the 9:00am mass at Holy Family Church. This weekend they celebrate the Rite of Acceptance into the 7-week program. Please remember them in your prayers. The RCICCA program is different from the other Parish sacramental program, that you may be familiar with, as the children enrolled in the RCICCA program have not yet been baptised and therefore cannot receive Confirmation or First Eucharist.


