#### **ECUMENICAL CORNER**

The key message in the story of the Good Samaritan in Luke's Gospel is often missed by those who read it. In response to the question "Who is my neighbour?" posed by a rich young Jewish lawyer in an attempt to trick Jesus, is cleverly turned back on him by Jesus. The good neighbour in the story turns out to be, a hated heretic from Samaria. Those who had previously passed by the wounded Jewish man in the road were Jewish religious leaders who feared becoming ritually unclean by touching him. Jesus' message is that everyone is our neighbour no matter who they are. At the conclusion of Christian unity week, Pope Francis in speaking on this Gospel, challenges us to reflect on the question: **Do I, and then my community, my Church, my spirituality, act like a neighbour?**"
