Did you know...

Did you know about our Provincial Seminary in Brisbane?

Our Diocese has recently enjoyed the ordination of Fr Peter Doherty, ordained a Priest on 22nd February 2024. Before that, he was ordained a Deacon for the Diocese on 20th July 2023. And before *that*, he was a student at Holy Spirit Seminary in Banyo, Brisbane. The seminary journey is a graced one where the priestly vocation is tested and nurtured. Seminarians live, study and pray amongst like-minded brothers, and enjoy the wisdom of a rich staff including Priests, Consecrated Brothers and Sisters, and laypeople. In years gone by, Bishop Michael was Rector of the Seminary; more recently (during my own formation) Mons John Grace served as Rector. It really is a privileged time set aside for discernment, studies and all-round maturation for pastoral life and ministry.

Holy Spirit Seminary is a *provincial* seminary, meaning it serves all of the five dioceses in Queensland (the "Province of Brisbane"); us in Rockhampton, as well as Cairns, Toowoomba, Townsville, and Brisbane itself. These five dioceses are symbolised by each of the *five stars* on the Seminary crest. With Fr Peter now in ministry, we have one Rockhampton seminarian currently in formation at HSS, Grant Sutherland. And, please God, *more local men* will test and nurture a call to the priesthood at HSS in the coming years.

For the sake of the local Church, our spiritual and monetary support of Holy Spirit Seminary is needed. Fr Peter, soon to arrive in Gladstone, is the direct product of such support. Please keep HSS in your prayers, browse their website, like their Facebook page and invite others, and consider how you might support the Seminary's necessary work - especially during this Seminary Appeal weekend.

May all of us seek to know you better, to faithfully follow your call to holiness, and proclaim the gospel to the world.


