Did you know...

Did you know? | Ordinary Time is not 'ordinary'

Our liturgical year is defined by various seasons; Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter and Ordinary Time. You will have noticed that we have returned now to the Sunday readings of Ordinary Time, the previous few weeks having readings for Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi.

The English word 'ordinary' might conjure up various sentiments which can give us a false sense of what Ordinary Time actually means.

Our secular understanding of 'ordinary' might equate to 'everyday', 'usual', 'pedestrian', 'not-special', 'common', 'standard', 'routine', 'mundane', or 'not meaningful'.

Liturgically, however, the ordinary in Ordinary Time does not refer to a season of dull routine but rather the listing of *ordinal*, or *sequential*, numbers. This is what is meant by the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, etc.

The season of Ordinary Time consists of 33 or 34 weeks and is divided into two parts. The Roman Missal instructs that Ordinary Time *"begins on the Monday following the Sunday after January 6 and continues until the beginning of Lent; it begins again on the Monday after Pentecost Sunday and ends on the Saturday before the First Sunday of Advent."*
