# **About the Theological Virtues?**

Virtues are the habits or patterns of behaviour that reflect the ideals of Christian morality. St Thomas Aquinas defined a virtue as 'an habitual and firm disposition to do the good'. We say a person possesses a certain virtue if that person regularly practises such virtuous behaviour joyfully and easily. Christian tradition has spoken about both theological and human virtues.

The theological virtues are **faith**, **hope** and **charity**. These virtues have God himself as their origin, motive and direct object. That means that they are infused in a person directly by God and they give a person the capacity to live in a relationship with the Trinity.

<u>Faith</u> is the virtue that enables us to believe in God and in all he has revealed to us, because God is Truth itself. By faith a person freely commits him or herself to God.

**Hope** is the virtue by which we desire eternal life as our happiness and by which we wait for this gift from God.

<u>Charity</u> (love) is the virtue by which we love God above all things and our neighbour as ourselves. It is the foundation of the other virtues, to which it gives life, inspiration and order.

# World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly




