ON THE RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD

November presents the People of God with a particular focus: we pray for the faithful departed, our deceased loved ones and all souls in purgatory. We also celebrate and call on the saints in heaven to pray with and for us. But this isn't just a pious November thing. Every Sunday we recollect Easter, Christ's definitive victory over sin and death. We profess the Creed, too, which boldly proclaims our belief "in the resurrection of the body" / "the dead", "and life everlasting" / "in the world to come."

Indeed, the faith in which we were baptised and renew as we share Eucharist culminates in proclaiming the resurrection of the dead on the last day. This concerns not only the immortal soul but the raising of the mortal body - yes, even if cremated, even if lost to the forces of nature, etc. It does not matter what happens to our bodies, God wills to gather them up again on the last day (cf. CCC 988-991). Did you know this? Do you believe it? If in doubt, consider not only Christ's Ascension but Mary's Assumption. God means to raise you - all of you - to himself.

Over the course of this month, pray with the Church for your deceased loved ones: pray for all who have died, especially those who may have no one to pray for them; ask for the prayers of the saints who go before us and are yet with us on our journeys; ask our angels to pray for us; hallow the bodies of the deceased by visiting their graves or praying at the cemetery; and consider your own journey which will cross the threshold of death.

"How can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised; if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain, and your faith is in vain.... But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep." (cf. 1 Cor 15).





ECUMENICAL CORNER—

On 11 October 2024, Christian leaders of different denominations joined Pope Francis in the Vatican's Protomartyrs Square to celebrate an ecumenical vigil, together with thousands of believers from around the world thus marking the 62nd anniversary of Vatican II and the 60th anniversary of the Vatican II document: Unitatis redintegratio (Decree on Ecumenism) which was the catalyst for a new era of ecumenism in the Catholic Church . In his homily, Pope Francis, reflecting on the lessons learned from the synodal process, reminded the faithful that "Christian unity is not uniformity", but, rather, "harmony . . . which is brought to life by the Holy Spirit for the benefit of all Christians".
